Conference Update

he 2013 NRA Government Affairs Summit, held in Washington D.C. on March 17th through March 19th was excellent.

A Business Panel discussed current federal policy and legislation that impacts the recruitment, hiring and retention of employees with disabilities in both the public and private sector. The discussions included the President's Executive Or-

der # 13548 and changes in Schedule A regulations which impact the hiring requirements and process in the federal government.

The Honorable Janet LaBreck, Commissioner, Massachusetts Commission for the Blind, has been nominated by President Obama to be the next Commissioner of the Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) in the U. S. Department of Education spoke and was most informative about programs in Massachusetts. Ms. LaBreak is a very beautiful and intelligent lady.

Some of the other speakers were: The Honorable Lynnae Ruttledge, Member, National Council on Disability (NCD) formerly, Commissioner of the Rehabilitation Services Administration (RSA) in the U. S. Mary Fisher Murray, Combat Stress Recovery Program (CSRP), Wounded Warrior Project.
